# Business Card/ Postcard for your Local Group

CAN is offering to coordinate and pay for the design and printing of a promotional resource for your local group – in the form of either a business card or a folded postcard.

# Purpose to:

- promote your group
- promote the link between your local group and CAN as a national network
- increase group membership
- be a physical resource
- direct people to the CAN website and your local group webpage

# **Format**

- either a business card: 1 or 2 sided, 2 colour, 200/500/1000 per group or
- postcard: with fold, 2 colour, 200/500/2000 per group

### Uses

- business card: to hand out to other cyclists when you're biking past, to hand out at events
- postcard: to put between the spokes of bikes at events, to hand out at events, to have available to be picked up at events, bike shops etc

# What your group needs to do now

We want this resource to be available for you to use during Bike Wise month in February so we'll need to get going on this now.

- Decide with your group which of these resources (business card or folded postcard) you would like and let us know (Anne, Fiona, Patrick)
- for the business card send us your group logo if you have one and the details you would like on the card (see example below)
- for the folded postcard send us your group logo if you have one, tell us whether you want to use the green slogan or the freedom slogan (see attached), give us a photo and some written content this could include who you are, your aims, your projects, when your meetings are etc (see example below)

# What we'll do

We'll work with the designer to get a draft together, and then liaise with you to get a final version that your group is happy with. Then we'll get them printed and sent out to you.
