Ngauranga to Aotea Quay - Stage 1 Improvements to SH2 Northbound On Ramp

Improving the Management of Traffic

The Ngauranga to Aotea Quay project aims to keep traffic moving and reduce the frustrating stop-start instances experienced during peak times on this busy stretch of State Highway 1 (SH1). To realise early benefits and fit with other local roading projects, the project has been split into a number of stages. The early phase of this work was completed in August 2011 which included improvements to SH1 at Ngauranga including the provision of four lanes northbound and improvements to the merge area southbound.

The next phase of works involves improvements to the State Highway 2 (SH2) northbound on-ramp at Ngauranga to improve traffic flow and safety. These works include providing additional length of two-lanes, improving roadside barriers and pavement markings, and improving the merge area with SH2.

These works will commence in early February and are expected to be completed in June 2013 (weather permitting). During this time there will be traffic management measures in place. Drivers are asked to take extra care during the construction period.
