DCC giving the run-down on what is planned for cycling in Dunedin in the next few years. Time for Spokes Dunedin to get up to speed with the plan, help with prioritisation, and meet DCC Staff.

General meeting notes

People introduced themselves including their cycling interest and what they thought needed to happen to make cycling enjoyable in Dunedin.

Cycling interests included commuting and recreational (MTB, Road Cyclists, and tandems). A common theme for how to make cycling enjoyable in Dunedin was changing "driver behaviour". Some other issues were: discontinuous cycle facilities, glass and other maintenance issues with cycle lanes and shared pathways, workplace facilities for cyclists (lockers and showers), workplace travel plans, University secure bike parking (free for staff and students), segregated cycling facilities, opening up Dunedin's two old rail tunnels to walkers and cyclists, safety issues (perceived and real), and much much more.

Dick Martin who has held the position of Spokes Dunedin Chair for a number of years stepped down from Chair role but he is keen to stay involved and assist with submissions and audits. [Thanks Dick for all your work and staying with us albeit in a different role!]

It was agreed to meet in 2-3 weeks. Since the meeting a date has been set for **Thursday October 16 (5.30pm) Room 6 Clubs and Societies Building.** On the agenda will be DCC giving the rundown on what is planned for cycling in Dunedin in the next few years. A time for Spokes Dunedin members to get up to speed with the plans, help with prioritisation, and meet the DCC Staff. Also, will include a quick discussion about setting a date and a plan for holding an AGM. A notice will be sent out nearer the time to remind people but diary it in. Lets crowd out the room and show DCC how passionate and committed Spokes Dunedin is in making cycling happen in Dunedin.

Hamish Seaton (Mountain Bike Otago President) and Ben Wooliston (member of Cycling Otago) were keen to add the lobbying of these two groups to Spokes Dunedin.

A key theme of the meeting from a CAN perspective (Fiona) was leadership of and ownership of the group.
